Summary of Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) Activities

The Institution's Innovation Council (IIC) at Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Government Degree College, Bhadohi, established on 13 October 2020, aims to cultivate a vibrant innovation ecosystem among students and faculty. - Outreach & Dissemination: Programmes covering schools and social media engagement increased visibility and stakeholder outreach.
